<i>Definition and Sentence</i>	<i>Give an example or draw a picture</i>
Act: a formal decision or law by a legislature, ruler, court, or other authority <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Tariff: a tax or duty to be paid on a particular type of imports or exports <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Petition: a formal written request, typically one signed by many people, making a request to a leader about a particular cause <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Patriot: a person who strongly supports their country and is prepared to defend it against enemies <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Loyalist: a person who is loyal; a supporter of the existing government, especially in time of revolt <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Revolution: a sudden, complete (or significant) change in something <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Militia: a group of citizen soldiers (as opposed to professional soldiers) typically regarding themselves as defenders of individual rights <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Treaty: a formal agreement between two or more states in reference to peace, alliance, commerce, or other international relations <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	
Proclamation: a public and official announcement <hr/> <i>Use it in a sentence:</i>	

Natural Rights: fundamental human rights based on universal natural law (unchanging moral principles for all humans)

Repeal: the action of un-doing, revoking or annulling a law or congressional act

Treason: the crime of betraying one's country, especially by attempting to kill the leader or overthrow the government

Confederation: an organization that consists of a number of groups united in an alliance or league

Boycott: refusing to buy anything from or having any social relations with a country, organization, or person as a punishment or protest
